You must attend an application interview with the liaison and coordination supervisor faculty member of the university abroad, and apply by 3:00 p.m. on Friday, December 14 after verifying the requirements of your area of research, specific period you will be on exchange, and your application eligibility in terms of linguistic ability (TOEFL, IELTS, etc.).

When preparing your application, please notify your class homeroom teacher or supervisor. Interviews will be held in mid-January.
